



- CIPC (Copy of Company Registration Certificate) or affidavit for Sole Trader.

Additional information

- SBD 6.1 MUST be used by all service providers to claim points (obtainable from the website)
- Certified ID copy of director not later than 6 months
- Shareholders certificate or affidavit for Sole Trader.



Evaluation criteria

The evaluation criteria will use 80/20 Principles, where the points are formed by Price and the Specific Goals, Price is 80 points, and the Specific goals is 20 points. NB: SBD 6.1 must be used in order to claim points. Additional information i.e., id copies of directors (not older than 6 months certification) medical certificate and shareholders certificates.
